Kildare LEADER Programme 2014-2020	Following the LCDC/LAG meeting on 31 st March, the programme budget for the Kildare LEADER Programme 2014 - 2020 of €3,899,563.55 is 100% allocated. Sixty- Nine projects focusing on enterprise development, social inclusion and environmental initiatives have been allocated funding to support the development of Kildare through this funding stream.

LEADER Transitional Programme	Minister Humphries announced transitional funding for 2021 to support the continuation of the LEADER programme while the EU programme is being finalized. The information available at the LCDC/LAG meeting was that €358,746 is available for 2021. However, further funding could be made available but the exact allocation for Kildare was not known at the time of the meeting. It was agreed that the funding available will: a) Build on the foundation of the 2014-2020 Programme; b) Prepare Kildare for the next LEADER Programme: c) Support innovative and creative ideas from both individuals and communities.
