Cycle Against Suicide created the Community Buddy Initiative as a platform for peer-support within communities in a drive to promote a positive mental health dialogue among peers as a critical part of suicide prevention.

The Community Buddy team calls on all community and residents' groups to join their free online Peer-Support Training Programme.

Peer support is emotional and practical support between two people who share a common experience, and/or lived experiences. This training provides Peer-Supporters with the tools to cope when wanting to help a peer who has a mental health issue, or who just needs to talk through a problem.


