International Protection Integration Fund 2024



The International Protection Integration Fund celebrates rich cultural diversity and enables community based organisations across Ireland to play a greater role in supporting the integration of International Protection Applicants. Successful Scheme A organisations stand to receive grant funding of €30,000 − €100,000 to support large scale integration projects. Successful Scheme B organisations stand to receive grant funding of €2,000 − €10,000 to support smaller integration initiatives.

The closing date for receipt of applications is 12pm on 6th March 2024.

Local Enhancement Programme 2024



Kildare County Council through Kildare Local Community Development Committee has €198,071 to be awarded to community groups and organisations in Kildare allocated as follows:

€163,322 capital funding to use towards carrying out necessary repairs and improvements to facilities, energy efficiency type projects, purchase of equipment, etc. The minimum application amount is €1,000 and the maximum application amount is €10,000.

€34,749 capital funding for Women's Groups. There is a separate application form for Women's Groups. They can apply for funding under both application processes.

The closing date for receipt of completed applications is 5.00 pm on Thursday 29 February 2024.

2024 SunSmart Sunscreen Dispenser Pilot

This is an open call to all community groups/organisations to register their interest.

The Pilot Project involves provision of a sunscreen dispenser with a UV index display to a small number of community/voluntary groups who are involved in outdoor leisure activities to trial the unit from May to the end of August. This pilot is open to new applicants only and excludes those who previously took part in the pilot in 2023.

One litre of sunscreen will be provided along with each sunscreen dispenser board. NCCP will not be providing any extra sunscreen as part of the pilot. All pilot locations can keep the sunscreen dispenser board following conclusion of the pilot and can organise to re-order sunscreen cartridges directly for ongoing usage of the sunscreen boards. A re-order form will be sent out with the board if you wish to re-order sunscreen. If you do not think you have capacity to re-order sunscreen via your organisation or community group then please consider if this pilot is suitable for you to partake in.
